Meeting called to order at 6:35pm.

October minutes review. Motion to approve by D. Keeler, seconded by D. Morris.

Minutes approved.

Bibliotherapy purchase list and presentation by Ms. Shaw (SAFE Office) will be held until next meeting.

Concerns about rezoning are best held until Mr. Pylant is in attendance. New construction architectural maps displayed – grey areas are covered walkways. Administration offices to be moved to area that now houses chorus and band. Media center not to be all new construction – remodel only. Computer building (802) to become a music lab with cafeteria. Current cafeteria is to be knocked down for 2 story classroom building which will house all 6th through 8th grade core team teachers, planning areas, etc. Current 300 building to be remodeled for an ESE lab. Modular portable buildings will be added. Front fencing will not be chain link, but something complementary to architectural style. A facelift will be given to the gym to make it blend with architectural style of new buildings and locker rooms will be added. 200 science building will become an art or technology lab. Wheelchair access via elevator in new 2 story building and walkway to 300 building's second floor.

Q&A – for review from Mr. Pylant at next meeting and/or parent construction meetings:

Will the number of classrooms be the same as present number or are portables making up a difference/shortage? What will the order of construction be? How will square footage (number of classrooms and size of classrooms) compare to present school size? How will access to the cafeteria for after hours events be improved? Will there be covered parking in student pick-up areas (bus & parent loops)? How can we improve the campus lighting situation? Will student lockers be included? Will the new 2 story classroom building use

student IDs to access the building as the new construction at other schools are using?
Will security / alarm systems be adequate?

Last year's school survey distributed. This year's survey can still be done online as we did last year. Too many changes to this year's survey can lead to the inability to compare results or show progress. We need to discuss what communication method works best to produce better participation in survey.

- Can Ms. Shaw or other school staff member formulate a student survey? The results could be published in the Rebel Yell school newspaper. How will the results be made actionable?
- Survey question #1-2: Discuss possible revision – “after contacting school personnel, I feel that my concerns were dealt with in a satisfactory manner.”
- Survey question #5: How did students receive information about K-12 Planet if the parents couldn't come to pick up the information at school? Why does this program work well in high school, but not for middle school? What ways can we determine will provide action at the county level to improve K-12 Planet?
- Survey question #6: Are parents aware that IB will be a magnet program next year?
- Survey question #9: Additional guidance support is needed
- Survey question #10 is vague – discuss revision.

December meeting will fall during winter break. Motion made by Dawn Morris to skip December and make January 18th our next meeting. Seconded by Doris Keeler. Meeting date approved. **Next meeting is January 18th at 6:30pm in the media center.**
